During the period [redacted] was employed at Everfresh Juice Company, located at 6000 Nine Mile Road, Warren, Mi as a quality control technician and my immediate supervisor was Susan Guss, Quality Control Manager. During my employment, I noticed/observed the following practices:

- 1) an unknown German firm supplies Oleum 320^{UDEA} to [redacted] Company believed to be located in [redacted] (Canada). Oleum 320^{UDEA} is then shipped to Everfresh Juice Company. Both Companies are believed to be owned by Lablath's Brewery.
- 2) The antioxidant (Oleum 320^{UDEA}) enters the United States through the Port of Detroit in blue plastic five gallon containers for delivery to Everfresh.
- 3) Everfresh removes the product label from the five gallon containers and hides the product

5) Oleum 320^{(IDEA) 2/23} is added to orange juice to be packaged in plastic containers to increase the shelf life of the orange juice by retarding oxidation.

6) Oleum 320^{(IDEA) 2/23} is added during the mixing process of the concentrate and water.

7) The preservative in its natural state is milky white in appearance, and the firm adds food coloring to hide its normal appearance prior to adding it to a batch.

8) Batches with the preservative is filled into plastic containers under the following labels:
